

Troop 50 Virtual Scavenger Hunt

SAMPLE Clue – These are maroon, and we wear them in place of our formal uniform.

SAMPLE Answer – Troop 50 Class B T-shirt

1) Clues - this is part of the uniform, is the best source of scouting rank info, and every scout should have it with them

Answer – The Scout Handbook

2) Clue - this is what makes it permissible for any scout to either use or carry a pocketknife

Answer – Whittlin' Chit or Totin Chip

3) Clue – this disheveled set of items is often required at mealtime, can be metal or plastic, can be yours or belong to the troop

Answer – mess kit

4) Clue – these are considered by many as the most important item to be packed on any campout, but particularly when its cold

Answer – socks

5) Clue – you would need to have proven to your leaders that you can handle one of these safely and it can fit in a pocket

Answer – a pocketknife

6) Clue – this rolled up item is an essential part of any camper's checklist, primarily for comfort, especially if you don't have a cot, packs onto your backpack.

Answer – a bed roll or mattress

7) Clue – this item is the key to the dining hall at seven ranges, often whipped (but never nae-naed) or fused, can be used to prove scouting skills

Answer - rope

8) Clue – these are responsible for protecting your arches, your ankles, and for keeping your feet warm and dry

Answer – hiking boots

9) Clue – these types of items would best be used to refuel your body during or after a long day of hard work or hiking

Answer – healthy snack/trail mix

10) Clue – (this is an action item) regarding knots, in the words of the great band leader Huey Lewis “Here, there, and everywhere, it’s hip to be [this]”

Answer – tie a square knot for the camera

11) Clue – in order to spark some energy into any campout, you’ll need one of these (or maybe a few of them), can help immensely in cooking or keeping warm

Answer – matches, lighter, or fire starter

12) Clue – this item is a must have on any outing, can be in your backpack, your car, your campsite, your troop trailer, and houses items that you’d need in order to provide aid to yourself or others

Answer – first aid kit

BONUS ITEM (worth 10 points) Clue – without this item, this well-known phrase made popular by 7 Ranges camp director, Dan Nesbitt, has little meaning: “A hydrated scout is a happy scout. A dehydrated scout is a”

Answer – Canteen or water bottle
